**The Ordinary Time of the Church**, from the First Sunday after Trinity to the Last Sunday of the Church Year, comprises half of the calendar. This extended season of Green, is divided as we pass some of the lesser feasts in the coming months. Angels Tide commences as we approach the Feast of St. Michael and All Angels (September 29) and lasts until All Saints Day (November 01). The Gospel Readings around this time address the spiritual warfare of the church against the devil, the world, and all the principalities and powers of this present evil age.
