This extended season of Green, is divided as we pass some of the lesser feasts in the coming months. Martyrs Tide commences as we approach the Feast of St. Lawrence (August 10). The Gospel Readings around this time address the growth and fruits of Christian faith and love, manifested in bearing the cross, even unto death.
