Lutheran Church-Canada Convention Highlights

Opening Divine Service with 450 people from our congregations across Canada;
2 Congregations were received into Lutheran Church-Canada:
Shalom Oromo Lutheran Church in Winnipeg MB; and
Église Évangélique Luthérienne de La Réconciliation in Sherbrooke QC;
15 new pastors since the last convention were received into Lutheran Church-Canada;
Full church fellowship was declared with the Lutheran Church in Norway in Finland, whose bishop Torkild Masvie visited us last year;
President Rev. Dr. Timothy Teuscher was re-elected to a second term unopposed;
Rev. Michael Schutz, Pastor of Concordia Lutheran Church, Penticton BC, was elected Vice-President, replacing retiring Rev. Thomas Kruesel;
All three Regional Pastors were re-elected unopposed: Rev. Robert Mohns (West); Rev. David Haberstock (Central); and Rev. Marvin Bublitz (East);
Pastor Kurt Lantz was elected to the Commission on Nominations and Elections;
Rev. John Maxfield, Professor of History and Religious Studies at Concordia University of Edmonton, presented "Luther at the Diet of Worms";
Rev. Dr. Thomas Winger presented a Bible Study examining The Armour of God;
