Visitors to the Lord's Table

In Luther's upbringing, the term "righteousness" was understood as the truth by which God deservedly condemns those who have merited evil. In his study of the Bible, however, the Holy Spirit led him to see that Christ's righteousness is something we are freely given by God's grace through faith (Romans 3:22)! This wondrous truth was the basis for the Reformation. This wondrous truth is also the basis for the **Lord's Supper**, for herein Christ is present with His body and blood to give us His forgiveness. In joyful obedience to the teaching of Scripture, we practice closed communion, and ask guests desiring to commune to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before publicly confessing this faith with us.
