

Welcome guests and visitors.

We are glad to have you with us. For the time of Easter (Pre-Lent, Lent, and Easter), we will follow the order of Divine Service Setting One, beginning on page 151 of *Lutheran Service Book*. The bulletin insert will guide you through the service and provide you with the parts that are proper for this day called **Septuagesima**.

The Season of Pre-Lent

The greatest difference between the one-year and three-year calendars comes toward the end of the Epiphany Season. The one-year calendar has three Sundays of Pre-Lent before we reach Ash Wednesday. These three Sundays serve as a countdown of anticipation. Septuagesima, the Latin word for 70th, tells us that we are within 70 days of Easter. The significance of the 70 days is a reminder of the years of exile in Babylon for the Old Testament people of God before their return to Jerusalem. Sexagesima (60th) tells us there are approximately 60 days to Easter and Quinquagesima (50th) falls 50 days before Easter. During Pre-Lent we begin to observe some the customs familiar to the Season of Lent. We silence our Alleluias and the Gloria in Excelsis, as the exiles laid down their harps by the rivers of Babylon (Psalm 137).

We receive the Lord's Supper every Sunday In joyful obedience to the teaching of Scripture, the congregations of Lutheran Church-Canada practice closed communion. We would like you to commune with us, but because of the different teachings about this sacred meal we want you to know what we believe and confess before showing your agreement as you join us in this communion meal. Guests who desire to commune with us are thus asked to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before giving their public confirmation of what we believe and confess. Everyone who communes should fill out a communion card and leave it in the offering plate.
