### ***Our Order of Service***

For the Sundays of Trinitytide, we will follow the order of Divine Service Setting Three, beginning on page 184 of *Lutheran Service Book*. The bulletin insert will guide you through the service and provide you with the parts that are proper for **The Third Sunday after Trinity**.

**The Ordinary Time of the Church**, from the First Sunday after Trinity to the Last Sunday of the Church Year, comprises half of the calendar. This extended season of Green, is divided as we pass some of the lesser feasts in the coming months. *Trinitytide* will give way to *Apostlestide* as we approach the Feast of the Apostles St. Peter and St. Paul (June 29). The Feast of St. Lawrence, the Martyr (August 10), will move us into *Martyrstide*. The Feast of St. Michael and All Angels (Sept 29) takes us into *Angelstide* until All Saints' Day (Nov 1) and the last Sundays of the Church Year.

***We receive the Lord's Supper every Sunday*** In joyful obedience to the teaching of Scripture, the congregations of Lutheran Church-Canada practice closed communion. We would like you to commune with us, but because of the different teachings about this sacred meal we want you to know what we believe and confess before showing your agreement as you join us in this communion. Guests who desire to commune with us are thus asked to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before giving their public confirmation of what we believe and confess. Everyone who communes should fill out a communion card and leave it in the offering plate before the service.
