### **Wills and Living Wills Serve Very Different Purposes**

A Will, formally known as a Last Will and Testament, is used to outline the disbursement of your assets after death. In contrast, a Living Will, which comes into effect while you are still living (hence its name), gives direction regarding end-of-life decisions if you are not able to make them yourself. A Living Will is now more widely known in Ontario as a Power of Attorney for Personal Care. If you do not have these documents in place, your family will not be able to make all decisions on your behalf. If you want your Christian values known and followed, be sure to complete a Power of Attorney for Personal Care.
