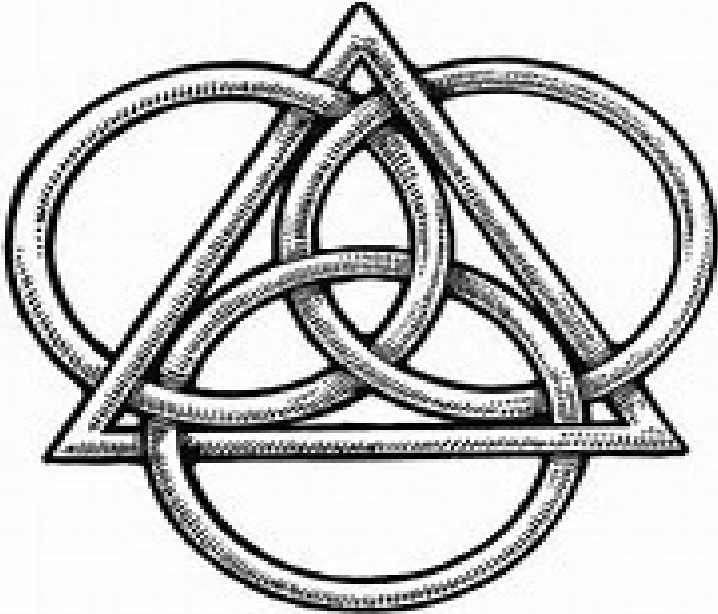

### ***Our Order of Service***

As we conclude the Time of Easter and the Festival half of the Church Year, we follow the order of Divine Service Setting One, beginning on page 151 of *Lutheran Service Book*. The bulletin insert will guide you through the service and provide you with the parts that are proper for **The Feast of the Holy Trinity**.

**The Feast of the Holy Trinity** is the octave (8<sup>th</sup> day) which closes out the celebration of Pentecost, and the entire festival half of the church year. Today we remember not only the doctrine of the Holy Trinity, but the Triune God Himself (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) and the mercy He has shown to us. On this day we confess the Athanasian Creed, and our worship celebrates the mystery and adoration of the One God in Three Persons.

***We receive the Lord's Supper every Sunday*** In joyful obedience to the teaching of Scripture, the congregations of Lutheran Church-Canada practice closed communion. We would like you to commune with us, but because of the different teachings about this sacred meal we want you to know what we believe and confess before showing your agreement as you join us in this communion. Guests who desire to commune with us are thus asked to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before giving their public confirmation of what we believe and confess. Everyone who communes should fill out a communion card and leave it in the offering plate before the service.
