

#### Visitors to the Lord's Table

John the Baptist prepared people for the coming of the Lord by preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. In like manner, we are to be prepared for the coming of the Lord in **the Sacrament of His very body and blood**. To assist you in this preparation, you may use the "Christian Questions With Their Answers" on page 329 of the Lutheran Service Book. Since reception of the Lord's Supper is also a public confession of the unity of our faith, guests are asked to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before communing.
