Our Order of Service

For the Time of Easter we will follow the order of Divine Service Setting One, beginning on page 151 of *Lutheran Service Book*. The bulletin insert will guide you through the service and provide you with the parts that are proper for **The Fourth Sunday of Easter (Jubilate).**

Easter is the celebration of the Resurrection of Our Lord. It is the highest feast of the Church Year. The Alleluias and Glorys that we silenced in preparation for this time are taken up again with the greatest joy. For 50 days we focus on the great news that the Resurrection of Jesus Christ is but the first. He will raise all the dead and give eternal life to all who believe in Him.

We receive the Lord's Supper every Sunday In joyful obedience to the teaching of Scripture, the congregations of Lutheran Church-Canada practice closed communion. We would like you to commune with us, but because of the different teachings about this sacred meal we want you to know what we believe and confess before showing your agreement as you join us in this communion. Guests who desire to commune with us are thus asked to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before giving their public confirmation of what we believe and confess. Everyone who communes should fill out a communion card and leave it in the offering plate before the service.
