Ontario District LWML-Canada Post Convention Highlights

6 mission grants were approved:

Spanish hymnals for Lutheran congregations in Nicaragua and Costa Rica - \$5,000

Sudanese mission work in Hamilton, Ontario - \$8,000

Outreach and Support for recent immigrants in Northern Ontario - \$3,000

New Bibles and hymnals for First Lutheran Christian Academy in Windsor - \$3,500

Radio and internet broadcast to the South Asian community in the GTA - \$5,000

Windsor Essex County Lutheran Outreach to immigrants - \$5,500

Offerings received at the convention included:

\$1,716.30 in Mites toward the mission projects listed above

\$1,429 to the Food Pantry at Concordia Lutheran Theological Seminary, St. Catharines

\$1,613.10 for the Refugee Family sponsored by Christ Lutheran, St. Catharines

\$4,611 for Gillian's Place, a local shelter for abused women and children

\$2,664.34 to Medical Missions

Report on the Lutheran East District Annual Meeting

1. Lois Griffin, Ray Taylor, Reg Tiegs, Rev. Robert Morley, and Rev. Richard Orłowsky were elected as the Board of Directors whose only function remains to wind down the Church Extension Fund and dissolve the corporation.

2. The East District Mission and Ministry Endowment Fund will be transferred to the Lutheran Church-Canada Mission Endowment Fund to support LCC domestic mission work.

3. Of the \$4.3M surplus CEF funds, 50% will be transferred to the LCC Mission Endowment Fund and 50% will be distributed among all the congregations of the East District.
