

Visitors to the Lord's Table

St. Bartholomew was one of the twelve apostles present when Jesus instituted the **Holy Supper** of His very body and blood, and he is also present with us today as we celebrate this foretaste of the feast to come. We are, as such, joined together with him and with "angels and archangels and the whole company of heaven" in ascribing all praise and glory to "the Son of God and King of Israel" who opens heaven to us in this Sacrament. As partaking of the Lord's Supper together presupposes and reflects our common faith in the apostles' doctrine, we practice closed communion and ask that guests speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before publicly confessing our common faith.

What Is That? - Words You Only Hear at Church

<u>Pastor's Vestments</u>: A pastor wears various vestments to cover up his individuality. The focus is not to be upon the man but upon the Office to which he has been called.

<u>Alb</u> - A close-fitting, white vestment for pastors, worn especially at the Divine Service with Holy Communion. The name comes from the Latin word for white, alba.

<u>Chasuble</u> - A "poncho" like vestment that is worn by a pastor only when he is administering Holy Communion. It is to be in the appropriate colour of the season.

<u>Stoles</u> - A scarf-like fabric usually crafted in the colour of the day or season, often bearing symbols appropriate to the day or season. It is worn over the shoulders of those ordained to the pastoral office.

<u>Vestry</u> - The vestry is a room where the pastor's vestments are stored and where he dresses.

<u>Sacristy</u> - From the Latin sacristia, meaning "holy things." The room where the communion vessels and paraments are kept. The vestments for the pastor and liturgical assistants may also be kept here.

LCC 2026 Synod Convention Updates

Lutheran Church-Canada President Timothy Teuscher and West Regional Pastor Robert Mohns have announced that they will not be letting their names stand for reelection at the 2026 Synod Convention. We give thanks to the Lord for their faithful and dedicated leadership in our synod over the past two convention cycles.

LCC's national office will send forms to congregations in September inviting nominations of clergy from LCC's roster for the offices of president, vice-president, regional pastors, and circuit counsellors. These nominations will be made at an upcoming voters' meeting before the February deadline.

Right now, any communicant member of a Lutheran Church-Canada congregation can individually recommend LCC pastors and lay people to serve on the various boards and commissions of the synod. Nomination forms, list of positions, and descriptions of their duties and responsibilities are available on the 2026 convention website at www.lutheranchurch-canada.ca/synod-convention-2026/recommendation-for-nomination-form.

LCC Mission - Oromo Outreach within Canada

The Oromo people are the largest ethnic group of Ethiopia, and also have a rich history in Canada, with a significant presence in the Greater Edmonton and Toronto areas. They have established communities and organizations that focus on cultural preservation, language education, and social interaction. This includes the Lutheran confession, as the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus is recognized as the largest Lutheran Church body in the world. Our LCC Oromo missions include congregations in Calgary and Winnipeg, as well as mission stations in Vancouver, Fort McMurray, and Edmonton. We have three Oromo pastors active in Lutheran Church-Canada.
