Concordia Lutheran Theological Seminary 50th Anniversary... Oct 19-21

CLTS St. Catharines has announced the celebration of its 50th Anniversary during the 2026-2027 academic year. Marking a half-century of theological education and service to the Church, the seminary will host a series of events centred on the theme "Forming the Future." The theme signals the seminary's commitment to theological truths of the Evangelical Lutheran Church while equipping future pastors and church leaders for the evolving cultural landscape of the 21st century.

Registration is now open for the highlight event of the anniversary year. This three-day festival features a multi-faceted programme designed to engage the Lutheran community, including: Seminary Open House; Alumni Reunion; Festival Service; and Theological Conference. Titled “Respectful Theological Dialogue in the Internet Age”, this conference will explore the challenges and opportunities of maintaining faithful theological conversations in a digital world.

The conference is open to pastors, church workers, and laity. To accommodate an international audience, the event will be held at the Americana Resort & Spa in Niagara Falls, providing a beautiful backdrop for study and fellowship.
