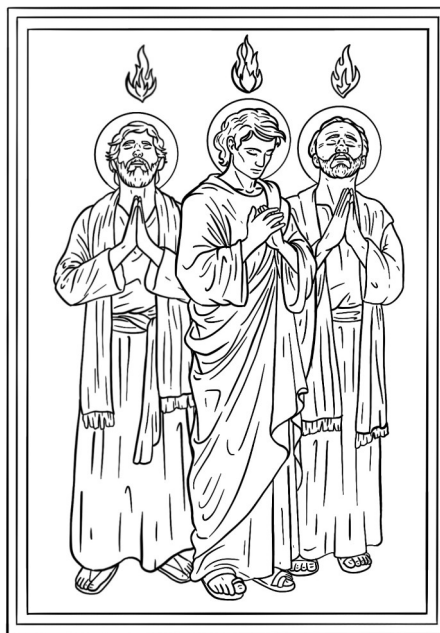

### **Visitors to the Lord's Table**

Jesus promised that it was to our advantage that He go away and send the Holy Spirit for His church (John 16:7). That advantage became evident on Pentecost as the Holy Spirit empowered the preaching of repentance and forgiveness and employed the use of Baptism and the **Lord's Supper** to build the church of Christ (Acts 2). The Holy Spirit is still acting for our advantage as Christ comes to us with His true body and blood in Holy Communion today. Because doctrinal oneness is central to the common reception of the Lord's Supper, we practice closed communion; and guests desiring to commune are asked to speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before joining us in the Lord's Supper.

### **Concordia Lutheran Theological Seminary 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary... Oct 19-21**

CLTS St. Catharines has announced the celebration of its 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary during the 2026-2027 academic year. Marking a half-century of theological education and service to the Church, the seminary will host a series of events centred on the theme "Forming the Future." The theme signals the seminary's commitment to theological truths of the Evangelical Lutheran Church while equipping future pastors and church leaders for the evolving cultural landscape of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

Registration is now open for the highlight event of the anniversary year. This three-day festival features a multi-faceted programme designed to engage the Lutheran community, including: Seminary Open House; Alumni Reunion; Festival Service; and Theological Conference. Titled "Respectful Theological Dialogue in the Internet Age", this conference will explore the challenges and opportunities of maintaining faithful theological conversations in a digital world.

The conference is open to pastors, church workers, and laity. To accommodate an international audience, the event will be held at the Americana Resort & Spa in Niagara Falls, providing a beautiful backdrop for study and fellowship.
