**POST-COMMUNION COLLECT**

*Due to the unified character of the services of the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil), the Benediction is omitted on this day.*

**STRIPPING OF THE ALTAR**

*Immediately following the Post-Communion Collect, the communion vessels are reverently removed from the altar, the altar stripped, and the chancel is cleared in preparation for the solemn service of Good Friday.*

*While this is done, Psalm 22 is sung entirely by the congregation.*

*The Gloria Patri is omitted.*
