Visitors to the Lord's Table

Those who partake of the **Lord's Supper** actually consume bread and wine (1 Corinthians 10:17). But more than that, they also receive a miracle in the bread and wine; for therein Christ places His true body and blood (1 Corinthians 10:16) as a sure pledge of forgiveness and eternal life. As His body and blood can be taken to one's judgment (1 Corinthians 11:29), the congregations of Lutheran Church-Canada have promised to practice closed communion. This practice also bears loving witness to the Bible's concern for doctrinal oneness in receiving Holy Communion. If you are a guest, we therefore kindly ask that you speak with the pastor to arrange for a time of instruction before joining us in the Lord's Supper.
